

Willis Tower Named “100 Great Things About America” By FORTUNE

CHICAGO – July 6, 2011 – Baseball, the internet and apple pie are just a sampling of the things that make America great. Now, the list of what’s great about America has a few more additions, including Willis Tower. This month, FORTUNE Magazine published its “100 Great Things About America” list, which features Chicago’s iconic Willis Tower.

“For decades, Willis Tower has been recognized the world over as a defining icon of Chicago and America,” said Randy Stancik, Vice President of U.S. Equities Asset Management, which manages Willis Tower. “From its architectural significance, to its status as the tallest building in North America, Willis Tower is truly a shining example of what makes America so great.”

At 110 stories, Willis Tower is Chicago’s signature office building. The Ledge adds a fifth view 1,350 feet straight down from a series of glass bays that extend from the west side of the building. Skydeck draws more than 1.3 million visitors annually.

Now in its second year, the “100 Great Things About America” list is a way to celebrate some of the country’s greatness while profiling 100 things that contribute to the tangible and intangible success and well-being of America.
